

**Notice: GP Internal Entity Changes – U.S. Consumer Products**

Effective December 1, 2017, Georgia-Pacific LLC and its **U.S. Consumer Products subsidiaries** (“GP”) are undergoing an internal restructuring to more accurately reflect how we organize and operate the consumer products business. Rest assured, we value our relationships with our suppliers, and business will continue as usual.

For the most part, it’s unlikely suppliers will experience any impact. However, there may be a change to the GP entity indicated on Purchase Orders issued for goods, equipment, and services **beginning December 1, 2017**. Most will be issued by **Georgia-Pacific Consumer Operations LLC**. However, there are some exceptions when i) GP is purchasing finished goods (in which case Purchase Orders will be issued by **Georgia-Pacific Consumer Products LP** in most instances and SPG Holdings LLC in other instances), and ii) Purchase Orders issued by the Mt. Holly facility, Consumer Products distribution centers, warehouses, and Neenah Technical Center. Additionally, GP will continue to own and use the Dixie® brand, but, among other changes, all purchases formerly made by Dixie Consumer Products LLC will now be made by one of the primary two existing GP entities in bold above, depending on what is being purchased. **Regardless, suppliers need only ensure, as always, that the GP entity indicated on the invoice and any related documentation, including without limitation, any U.S. customs documentation, mirrors the GP entity on the corresponding Purchase Order.**
